Review the Steps


Let's help you get started with a brief overview of the steps:

- 4. Add the event to a Calendar.

Step 1: Select Small Groups from the All Groups Page


Using your mouse or your finger, select or press anywhere on the Small Groups area of the screen.



Step 2: Select the Group You Wish to Attend


Find the small group you wish to attend on the Small Groups home page.

Select anywhere on the group's image to go to the small group's information page.




Step 3: Select an Upcoming Event



Choose one of the two options from the drop-down list:



- All group events




